

Anatomic design, which is fully disposable and does not require any Capital investment



A. the LEDPad - a reusable multilayer body-shaped wrap that covers the entire body except for the hands and head.

The LEDPad is provided for free.



B. The Wrapper – disposable, thin and transparent, with two layers of non-woven fabric (with Velcro tabs) that covers the LEDPad. The Wrapper is a single-patient use.



C. A controller with a power supply. The Controller and power supply are provided for free.
